





Hi Eddie,

I understand from Trish you have requested further information on Director Martin and possible options.

The following has been put together by Nigel.

On February 17, I provided you with advice on Director Martin's attendance at ILC and AIA Board meetings, as per your request.

I wish to advise you that as at today, Director Martin has missed 3 consecutive ILC Board meetings without granted leave. Apologies were not forthcoming for the following meetings, nor leave granted.

- 1 February 2018
- 21 February 2018
- 9 March 2018

Subsequently, I am forwarding further advice provided by Nigel Wilson.

With regard to Director Martin's AIA Directorship, as part of the Transition Plan his role as AIA Director is to cease at the April ILC Board meeting, and he is to be replaced by an unpaid ILC Director who will act in this role for compliance duties only.

With regard to Director Martin's ILC Directorship:

- Section 192H(4) provides that "If an Indigenous Land Corporation Director who holds office on a part-time basis is absent, except on leave granted under section 192C, from 3 consecutive meetings of the Indigenous Land Corporation Board, the Minister must terminate the appointment of the Director".
- Section 192G provides that "An Indigenous Land Corporation Director may resign by writing signed by him or her and sent to the Minister."

Director Martin can resign himself pursuant to s.192G, or the ILC could invite him to do so. However, Nigel believes the limited contact from Director Martin makes this unlikely.

Nigel therefore recommends that the ILC write to Minister Scullion advising of the situation.

Depending on the advice and actions from Minister Scullion we will need to determine April Board meeting invites.

Please advise if you wish the ILC to draft a letter to Minister Scullion.



- Table 7 Board Meetings Board Meeting Numbers 214-219 (inclusive) would have taken place in 2017 rather than 2018 as listed.
- Table 7 Board meetings Mr Martin was absent from 8 Board meetings out of 12 in total, had leave of absence for one meeting, and did not attend 7 (including 3 in succession). ILC may consider adding a footnote explaining the absences.

Our review hasn't involved a full editorial check, we recommend that a full proof read and edit be undertaken prior to the report being sent to the Minister.

We look forward to receiving the final proof of the CLC annual report in due course.
