



Recruitment Privacy Statement

The Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (ILSC) is subject to the provisions of the *Privacy Act 1988* ("Privacy Act") as amended from time to time, which requires that we comply with the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) set out in the Act. These APPs set out how organisations such as ILSC should collect, store, use and disclose personal information and how individuals can access records containing their personal information.

In order to properly assess your application for a position with the ILSC or one of its wholly owned subsidiaries, the ILSC needs to collect the personal information contained in your application documents.

The ILSC may need to disclose the personal information to one of its wholly owned subsidiaries, other Government agencies or the Commonwealth Government but only if necessary to assess this application, for a related purpose, or if required by law.

Your application documents may contain the personal information of other people such as referees. You should tell someone if you put their personal information in this application and make sure they are aware of this privacy statement. Even if a person is not made aware that their personal information has been included in this application, the ILSC will still collect that personal information for the purpose of assessing your application.

The ILSC's Privacy Policy contains further information about how the ILSC will treat personal information, including when it may disclose information, as well as details of how you can access your own personal information or how to make a privacy complaint.
