The Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (ILSC) is a corporate Commonwealth entity established under the ATSI Act and subject to the PGPA Act. The ILSC assists Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to realise economic, social, cultural and environmental benefits that the ownership and management of land, water and water related rights can bring. The ILSC provides this assistance through the acquisition and management of rights and interests in land, salt water and fresh water country.

The ILSC is seeking an organised and motivated self-starter to work in a challenging and rewarding team environment. Under the direction of the Operations Manager, develop and assess land and water acquisition and management enquiries and work with Indigenous organisations to progress projects to the point they are ready for ILSC investment; collaborate with Indigenous organisations to manage land towards a divestment outcome; and collaborate with existing Indigenous land owners to maximise opportunities to improve the Indigenous estate.

Reporting to the Operations Manager you will:

- negotiate with stakeholders and facilitate a collaborative approach to project development to maximise benefits to Indigenous landowners
- Manage existing and new land and water acquisition and management projects
- Plan, negotiate, develop and maintain effective relationships with stakeholders and agencies in order to foster beneficial partnerships to enhance and extend the application of ILSC Programs
- Undertake research, market analysis, project scoping, due diligence and feasibility analysis
 of projects to establish the business case for ILSC investment
