Reporting to the Manager Strategic Projects you will:

- Conduct day to day management and coordination of the ranger program through engagement with Traditional Owners and Indigenous Rangers, build their knowledge, skills and capability.
- Implement the divestment strategy and oversee the implementation of an annual work plan and property budget. Identifying and prioritising natural and cultural resource management including; fire management, cultural heritage management, biodiversity monitoring, pest plant and animal control, track repairs, infrastructure, plant and equipment maintenance.
- Develop effective collaborations with Indigenous groups to implement the divestment strategy and oversee the implementation of an annual work plan and property budget identifying and prioritising natural and cultural resource management.
